Annually, the Chicago Athenaeum: Museum of Architecture and Design confers the Good Design Award to honor contemporary and extraordinary innovative design. The award can be traced back to the Good Design Program, which was launched in 1950 with the participation of outstanding designers like Eero Saarinen or Charles and Ray Eames.
